

Advent

<u>Focusing on Advent</u>—the period beginning four Sundays before Christmas—

can help us to slow down and appreciate this part of the year. It is a holy time that is marked by a sense of waiting and prayerful reflection. Advent is traditionally celebrated with <u>lighting</u> <u>candles</u> on a wreath each Sunday, while focusing
