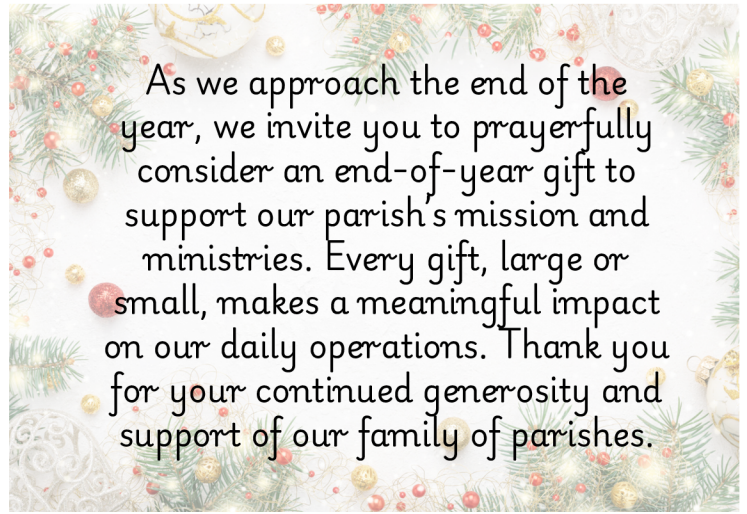

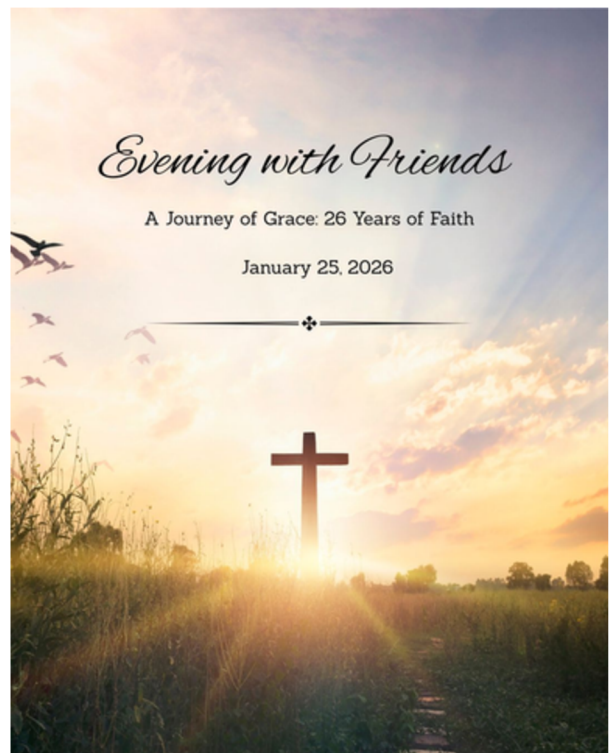

Dear parishioners,

This weekend we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Family, so I will continue with the theme of God and His plan for family. To do that I want to focus on a prayer that we don't usually think of as a Christmas prayer or a family prayer, the Our Father.

Jesus gave us this prayer when he was an adult because He wasn't teaching until then, but it was his goal right from the beginning of his life on earth. Mary would have told him that God was His father and that Joseph was his stepfather. She would also have told him about how God was the real king of Israel, but that King David became his stand-in. Jesus would have learned that He was in that royal lineage of David. His goal was to get everyone into that kingdom through baptism. That is why he told us to say, "Our Father" not my father. "Thy kingdom come, thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven" went to full speed with Jesus being born in Bethlehem, the city of David. The will of God the Father was being fulfilled on earth as it was in heaven, and as it was stated in Paradise, when God said to the serpent, "I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your offspring and hers..."

The love of Mary and the love of Jesus, even as a baby, was the exact opposite of what the devil wanted, but exactly what God the Father wanted. His Word has now become flesh and was dwelling among us. Getting the rest of us in line would not be as easy. So, we are told to pray that God as our father will provide for us by giving us our daily bread, but also forgiving us, his wayward children.

For us to become family, we don't just have to have a connection with God the Father. We need to recognize that He is our father. That means we need to play nice with each other, or as Jesus says, "forgive those who trespass against us." "Lead us not into temptation" is the Father being asked to help us fight the work of the devil. "Deliver us from evil" ultimately happens when we are in heaven. Any place else the devil would still find ways to tempt us away from the royal family we are meant to be a part of.

Much of this came to my mind as Fr. John and I were doing penance services. The one aspect of a penance service that doesn't necessarily happen when you simply go to confession is that we say the Lord's Prayer together. Right after we recite the Act of Contrition, as a way of expressing our sorrow for hurting the family, we recite the Our Father to remind us of how the Sacrament of Reconciliation rebuilds or strengthens those bonds with the Father and his family. It is like Jesus had this planned from the beginning. Of course, you should know that he did have it planned from the beginning.

Have a peaceful celebration of the Holy Family, and a Happy New Year!

- Reduce habits that pull you away from prayer or peace.
- End each day with an examination of conscience and gratitude.
