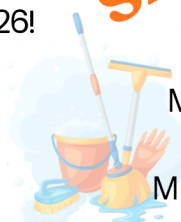

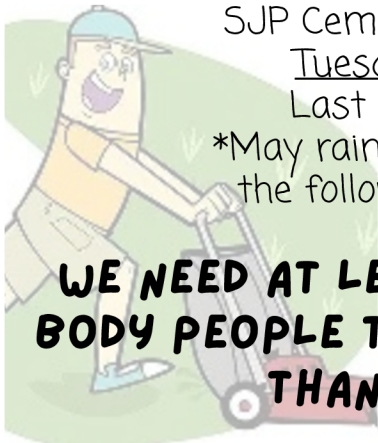

From the Desk of **Father Frank**

Dear parishioners,

In looking at our preparation for our lives in the new heavens and the new earth, we are talking about vices vs. virtues. Last week it was about fighting the vice of greed and building on a virtue of generosity. What I tried to show was that wisdom must be applied, or it becomes a mess. God wants us to use the gifts he gives us. Living in poverty is not the goal. Having a generous heart and wisely guiding others toward that virtue is the goal. Then we can help others to our heavenly home as we get there also.

It is the same with our sexuality. Like the other gifts that God gives us, it has a purpose, but it needs to be used wisely. That is called the virtue of chastity. Its opposite is lust. For those of us who are old, we remember a world that wasn't saturated with lust, so we can usually recognize it. For some of those in our younger generations, they have never experienced a world that wasn't swimming in lust. It is as alien to them as a world without computers. This is why it is hard to help them understand chastity. They don't know what it would involve.

They have a hard time understanding why self-gratification is problematic. They think of it as harmless. Pornography is commonplace in their lives. Sex outside of marriage is portrayed in just about every media source around them. Since they have lived this way for so long, they wonder why some of us see it as a problem. They don't relate it to what their lives in the new heavens and the new earth would be like.

Just like greed, it would ruin us for that next life. Without a generous heart we are going to have a hard time living with a God who hates greed and saints who see it as sick. Lust will be seen as disgusting for it will stick out like thieves robbing a bank in broad daylight. It will seem tragic because it will seem so childish in a place of absolute virtue.

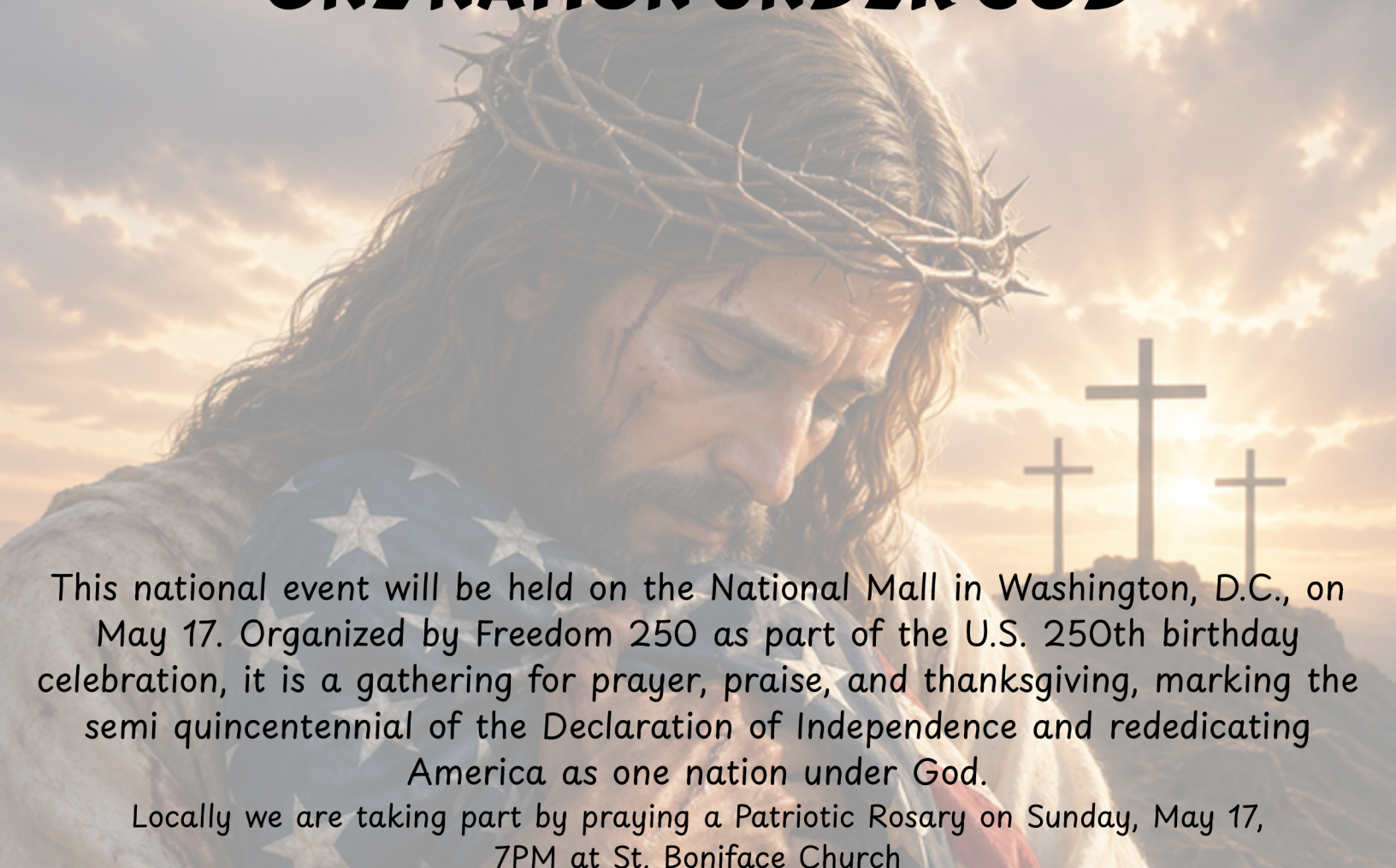
God has been trying to train us for this new existence in which only virtue will make sense. There will be another place where nothing will make sense, because vices will thrive there. We must choose our path. I suggest having Jesus be your way, truth, and life. This has become more difficult in the past few decades, but no less important. Jesus has taught generations of people to live chaste lives. He does not want us to see each other as objects suited only for pleasure. This is the result of a mind that has not been disciplined enough to avoid temptation or grow to see the way Jesus and Mary see them. They would never look at you as a sex object but would see you as someone who could be a magnificent addition to their royal family. We are meant to be princes and princesses, with tremendous dignity and ready to do great things as a part of God's plan.

We could ruin our role in God's plan by focusing on the wrong things, like lust or greed. But think of all the things that would have to change. Just like we would need to see the resources around us as things to use wisely, so we would have to learn to use our sexuality exclusively within the range of its purpose, which is to bring new life into the world in a way that would help that new life to also attain salvation. Using artificial birth control is selfish because sex is no longer seen as something that is meant to be a part of creation. There should be no more thinking that we should find our own gender niche, but rather figuring out how we can fit into God's predetermined plan for us as humans. You get the idea.
