Old Business:

1. 88% of Altar Society members paid their dues.
2. Discussed giving a donation for the repair of paint from water damage in the church. Lynell told us they aren't ready to accept donations yet. They are just getting bids for the repairs.

New Business:

1. There have been some low numbers when circles clean the church it was discussed if we should hire all the vacuuming done. Carol made a motion that we wait 6 months after a letter is sent out explain about cleaning and updating guidelines. There was a second to the motion and it passed to wait 6 months. The officers will get together to write the letter it will include where supplies are, instructions and guidelines for vacuuming. It was also suggested that this information be put on the web site.
2. The 2021 Thanksgiving Bazaar will once again be all carry outs. It was decided to ask each parishioner to give \$75 and there would be no credit for food. We will plan on serving 1000 so will need 45 turkeys, approximately 50 desserts and 60 pies. Estimating each circle will ask for 7 turkeys and 166 desserts (pie 8 pieces dessert 15 pieces) until real numbers are known. Orders will be taken from October 1-November 15.
