### **Old Business**

1. Gym Kitchen Sink Update - The cabinet above the sink has been taken down and stored in the SB Gym. Brenda will offer it to Pope John. If it cannot be repurposed somewhere at the parish or school it will be placed on the Parish Auction. Dave Gossman is set to begin the sink replacement this week.
2. Fr. Vogel's Farewell Open House served 204 people. Leftover meat and cake were given to the priests and taken to Tintern for summer retreats.
3. Brenda reported that the parish is paying rent to St. John's for the rectory use and that includes the cleaning cost.

### **New Business**

1. A motion was made by JoAnn Beckman to donate \$3,000 for Parish insurance payment. Pam Dinslage seconded.
2. A new freezer was purchased for the Gym Kitchen by Brenda. The old one was hauled out by Alan Reicks. A motion was made to reimburse Brenda \$221.49 for the purchase by Verona Henn. The motion passed.
3. Coffee and Rolls for Father Sund will be held after 10:00 am Mass on Sunday, September 18, 2022 in the Church Basement. Circle 3 will prepare the food as their charity.
4. The Thanksgiving Bazaar will be both takeout and dine in. The cost was raised to \$18 per plate. The sausage price will be \$7.50 per pound package. Clean up will still be done on Thanksgiving Day. Serving will end at 1:30 pm. The kitchen will need a deep clean prior and after. Circles will be assigned to help do this. Food will be planned for 1,200 people. Circles Leaders will need to solicit 9 turkeys, 11 pies and 9 desserts. Emily will ask Starman Seed to donate disposable silverware/napkin packets. Setup and food prep on Tuesday and Wednesday will be done by volunteers. 10 more roasters will need to be purchased. Brenda will work with Michele on revisions to the Thanksgiving Solicitation letter that asks for the \$75 donation per family. The letter will be sent by the end of September and Circle Leaders are asked to begin calling for food donations on October 15th. There is no credit for food donations.
