The St. Boniface Altar Society meeting was held Monday, January 16, 2023 with 15 members present. The meeting opened with prayer. Minutes from the last meeting and the Treasurer's Report were read.

Correspondence: A thank you from the Linnaus family was read for the funeral dinner for Dave. The American Red Cross sent a thank you for sandwiches made for the blood drive.

Old Business:

1. Boyd's Electric cost \$767.09. Everything is finished with the gym kitchen.
2. Brenda talked with Dave Hoefer about cleaning the chairs and tables at the KC Hall. He said they are going to work on fixing and getting them cleaned. Let Anna know if we need to be covering the tables.
3. Brenda talked with Michele about the men giving money to Spirit Catholic Radio and the money must come through parish council and there hasn't been a parish council meeting since August. Lynell Morgan made a motion that we go ahead and give \$500.00 dollars to Spirit Catholic Radio for a new tower to go up in O'Neill. Jan Heithoff seconded the motion. The motion passed.

New Business:

1. Discussion was held on suggesting members follow 3 salad recipes for funeral dinners. This will allow salads to be combined easier and will help Circle Leaders know the quantity of salads coming in. The three salad recipes selected were for fruit salad, macaroni salad, and coleslaw with creamy dressing. Anna will get the recipes updated and typed up so they can be sent out with the annual dues letters in February. She will stress that this is a suggestion and salad donations of any kind are always welcome.
2. We have raised out funeral dinner per plate cost to \$4.00 a plate. It was discussed how we will split the \$1.00 raise per plate. Carol Eischeid moved that we split the \$1.00 with the KCs so each group receives 50 cents. The motion passed. The KC's will receive \$1.75 per plate and Altar Society will receive \$2.25.

3. A revised letter for the annual dues donation was discussed. Anna Meis made a motion that we increase the amount that a physically able to help but non participating members dues to \$225.00 and leave all the other dues the same. Tracy Schindler seconded the motion. The motion passed.
4. Brenda inducted out new president Anna Meis. We are still in need of a vice president. Brenda also inducted the new circle leaders that were present. The new circle leaders are as follows:
