### **Old Business:**

1. President Anna passed around the three salad recipes that will be sent with the dues letters. It was stressed that these are only suggestions for salads at funerals and that any type of salad may still be made.
2. It was discussed how to get the baptismal crosses to parents when their child is baptized. Anna is going to talk with Becky Kerkman because it is our understanding that she coordinates the baptisms.
3. We still need a vice president if anyone has suggestions let Anna know. Susan Kallhoff is the new Circle 3 leader.

### **New Business:**

1. Anna informed us of the net profit for the 2022 Bazaar which was \$53,938.59.
2. The Altar Society is again asked to do food during the Parish Auction which is March 18. It was decided last year that the Altar Society will purchase the hamburger to be made into sloppy joes. 10 # of hamburger makes 1 1/3 buckets of sloppy joes. The work list is as follows.
  - Circle 6 – 4 buckets of sloppy joes, 30# of hamburger to be purchased at Dean's
  - Circle 2 – 4 buckets of sloppy joes, 30# of hamburger to be purchased at Dean's
  - Circle 1 – 12 dozen individually wrapped bars or cookies
  - Circle 3 – 150 buns and set up/ prepare coffee & water/ set out free will box
  - Circle 4 – work 4:30 – 6:30 – 2 workers
  - Circle 5 – work 6:30 to end – 3 workers

3. A reminder for circle leaders that when there is a women's funeral to have someone to say the rosary at the wake. These women were given as suggestions to call to lead the rosary Betty Getzfred, Jan Henn, Gwen Beckman, Jodine Meis, Linda Kerkman.
4. There is no Holy Saturday Mass at our church this year so no vacuuming is needed of dried candle wax.
5. We may have a coffee/ roll reception on June 4 for Zach Eischeid when he becomes a Traditional Deacon and for Fr. John's 10<sup>th</sup> Anniversary.
6. Anna passed out prayers for each of us to pray for a fellow Altar Society person this next month.
7. We were reminded that at the end of the meeting we would prepare dues letters to be sent out.
8. A discussion was held about cleaning and painting the storage closet off of the women's bathroom in the church basement. It was assigned to circle 3 for a charity and if they need help circle 4 will also help.
