**On Thanksgiving Day (if getting carry-out or dining in) .....please enter the gym at the North EAST door**

**Please enter northEAST entrance of gym.** You can then drop off or purchase raffle tickets, pay for your meal(s), pick up meals then EXIT through lobby. In the lobby is Sausage Sales and Gun Raffle Tickets (drawing is on Thanksgiving this year so get your tickets prior to or that day)  
**To speed up the process, have your correct amount for your meal payment ready,**  
*Cash or Checks only. Meals are \$18/each*

**Please bring your own box(es)** when you pick up your meal(s) for Carry-out.  
**Please arrive only at the time you were assigned,** between 11:00 am – 1:30 pm Large orders of 12 or more are asked to take whole pies and uncut desserts when possible.

**RAFFLE and QUILT TICKETS** It is preferred that sold tickets be returned prior to Thanksgiving via US Mail to PO Box B, Elgin or by dropping them at the parish office in Elgin (mail slot on inside door), since we have less people/shorter shifts on Thanksgiving Day. Or, please have them at the gym prior to 12:30 pm on Thanksgiving Day. More tickets are at church entrances through the day before Thanksgiving.

**Sausage:** Limited amount of Rings and Patties will be available on only a first-come, first-serve basis, only on Thanksgiving Day. If you are interested in RIBS, ask at the sausage booth!
