Old Business:

1. A write up about the Thanksgiving Bazaar from Emily was given to everyone
2. Lynell Morgan and Pam Dinslage are taking care of reupholstering the chairs in the front of the church.
3. It was discussed that Denise Dreger would only need to clean the convent 2 times a year. Anna Meis will talk with her and see if she is still interested in continuing this.
4. Anna purchased two coffee pots. One was taken to the KC Hall and the other one is in its box in the basement of the church.
5. Anna passed out an information sheet about supplies that need to be taken to the gym if there is a funeral there.
6. Lynell Morgan has volunteered to wash the server robes. She washed them before Christmas, will have it done again before Easter and after the summer months. They will be washed 3 times a year.

New Business:

1. It was discussed to leave dues the same when the dues letter goes out in February. We will stuff envelopes at the February meeting.
2. a. A discussion was held about forming a cleaning committee because circles are having trouble getting enough people to help clean, we would need 8 people. They would clean once a month.

b. It was also discussed about forming a funeral committee, we would need 10-12 people for this. It was discussed that the people on the funeral committee would organize the dinner and the circles would still help provide food and worker if they were needed.
