5. A small discussion was held about all of the food left from a funeral dinner. It was suggested to encourage the family to have meals at the KC Hall and let the families know not as many people stay for the meal, especially in the middle of the week. Bob Moore said they will always take food at the County Jail and they greatly appreciate the food given to them. There were many original containers sent home with food from the Marin Schindler funeral and people were asked to bring them back to the shelf in the St. Boniface Church basement.

New Business:

1. Deb Beckman will write a thank you to the county men % Leigh Kluthe for all their help setting up and taking down tables and chairs for the Marin Schindler funeral.
2. A clarification was made that after a visitation/wake services the Altar Society will not provide a reception. Friends or relatives may provide a reception and use plates,

napkins, cups, and coffee that are in the Altar Society storage closet in the church basement. Supplies need to be checked prior to the event. Please contact the Altar Society President at 402-843-8274. To let them know you are offering a reception so we can have the priest announce this after the wake.

3. We haven't had Easter Vigil at our church for several years so we needed 3 or 4 volunteers to help vacuum and clean up wax after 8:30 Easter Vigil on Saturday, March 30. Verona Henn volunteered.
4. A discussion was held about the amount of money to spend on frames for First Communicants. It was decided that around \$20 was okay.
