1. Betty reported that the fixtures in the men's bathroom for the church basement seem to be okay. It was suggested to possibly replace the stall divider. Connie Dvorak was asked to check with Mike on what kind of bathroom stall dividers that could be put in.
2. The meal for Zach Eischeid's reception Sunday, June 2 will need 5 workers to help Jodene serve the meal. Circle 2 has the next charity so they will provide the workers. Three 9x13 fancy dessert will be provided by each of the following circles 1,3,4,5, and 6.

4. For everyone's information when supplies are needed for the church Sarah Hemenway the Business Manager at the parish office orders all supplies for all the parishes. Betty ordered paper towels for the church basement.
5. Connie Dvorak informed us that she has more plants to put out by the sign. The plants have been donated by Alan and Rita Weiss. They have donated many plants for our church landscaping. Deb will send them a thank you.

**New Business:**

1. We discussed the cleaning and funeral committees. Anna Meis and Verona Henn volunteered to be the leaders of the cleaning committees and Betty Getzfred and Patty Stoltz volunteered to be leaders of the funeral committee. The cleaning committee will start in June and the funeral committee will have the next funeral. Circle 5 volunteered to do the Delores Weldings funeral.
2. A request was made to support the students attending the Steubenville Conference for a donation of \$1000.00. A motion was made by Tracy Beckman and seconded by Connie Pelster to give \$1000.00 for the Steubenville Conference. Motion passed.

4. A thank you was expressed to circles 1 and 6 for doing the landscaping on the parish grounds. A thank you was also expressed to Pam Dinslage and Lynell Morgan for taking care of having the chairs reupholstered at the front of the church.
5. They are looking for Sacristans to set up before funerals. If anyone is interested let Betty know.
6. A discussion was held about hosting a Meet and Greet for the Women of the St. Boniface Parish. It was decided to have a wine and cheese gathering. Betty will check with Dean and Kim about the wine and cheese. The date was set for July 17 possible time is 6-8 pm.
