# **Communicating Change and Changes...**

Just like my aging in the pictures, growth and change happens in both intentional and unintentional ways. In the left picture from 2014, I was 27 and finishing classes in Rome as a new priest. In the right picture from 2019, I'm 32 and one month into this new assignment.

#### AN IMAGE: DRIVING THE BOAT



One of the images that I used with our administrative staff is that each parish and school corporation is like its own boat. So, as the head of seven different corporations (six churches and one central catholic school), I am charged with driving seven boats... if our communities all act independently, it means that when I am at the helm of one boat, I am absent from the helm of six other boats.

The vision and proposal is for us to not act like seven different boats, but the vision is for us to **work together to make disciples.** Becoming disciples is about us getting to heaven. Doing this **together is about how** we make this journey. My vision is that we will learn to function more like one big ship with one helm and one captain's chair than seven ships. This means that we need to have the same destination in mind.

Being larger means that we are not as nimble as a smaller organization. Things require more communication and planning... but this organizational model gives us greater stability and resources in accomplishing our goal.



**To avoid any confusion:** this parish grouping will continue to have separate corporations for our six churches and our central Catholic school. We are not merging, but we are coming together. The

archdiocese has never done this before, so we're figuring it out as we go.

Some changes have taken place or will be taking place in our communities and buildings, and I would like to share a few headlines. This may be a regular feature.

#### EWING REPAIRING HAIL DAMAGE AND LANDSCAPING

St. Peter's has replaced windows damaged by hail for the Church and rectory basements. Rock has been placed on the exterior of the church and around the rectory and looks great! The church bathroom had issues and needed to have the pump replaced. It now works as expected. Upcoming: St. Dominic's Hall will be resided, also needed due to hail damage.

#### **RAEVILLE'S KNEELERS TO BE REPADDED**

Years of devotion and worship have made the kneelers in St. Bonaventure worn. Through the generosity of a donor, we will be able to have the kneelers repadded. Thank you! Also, work is being done on the air conditioning for the parish hall to keep us comfortable.

#### PETERSBURG'S ENLIGHTENING VISION

With the change in mass times, attention is being given to the lighting inside St. John's Church. We're looking to brighten the space for our celebrations as best we can. Also, the main controller for the HVAC system in Werner Hall is needing replacement, and this will yield big energy efficiency savings. A big thanks to Hank for all his knowledge and work! Also, fencing for the new cemetery land is being made.






