

#### **Twenty First Sunday in Ordinary Time**



Over the next several weeks, we'll delve into these topics **Change** means things don't stay the same...

Identity is about being who we are...

Vision gives us direction to where we are going...

**Growth and Progress** doesn't mean things should stay the same...

**IDENTITY IS ABOUT BEING WHO WE ARE.** I don't feel that it's too farfetched to borrow this meme from Dory, the forgetful fish in the Finding Nemo film series. I'm not asking for some sort of 'existential crisis' with the question "Who am I?", but rather I'm thinking about what kind of outcomes we are hoping for in our parish, apostolates, and our parish grouping as a whole. It's worth some thought... what kind of outcomes do we want?

If I were to sum up our entire purpose to exist, I'd say that Together, We Make Disciples.

**By together,** I mean that we are a community and a community of communities. Our future is together. We each have a distinctiveness that is our parish community, and this is something to celebrate. However, we also have a place in the larger church of our diocese and the universal Catholic Church around the world.

**By disciples,** I mean followers of Jesus... I mean called by Jesus... I mean formed by Jesus... I mean friends of Jesus... I mean saved by Jesus... I mean redeemed by Jesus... The road to heaven and our eternal home requires the forgiveness of God and the sacrifice of Jesus for us on the cross. Even more so, we are invited to a real ongoing relationship with Jesus, by which God is encountered in our daily lives.

**By 'we make',** we reference our mission: what we do and why it's important. This specifically references our formation in the faith and the formation in faith of our children. Lumen Gentium, Vatican II's Dogmatic Constitution on the Church,

August 25, 2019 introduced the language of the family as the 'domestic church'. This is the first place where we encounter God and the life of faith. Parents, therefore, are the primary educators of their children in the way of faith. We communicate faith and its importance by what we prioritize, what we say, and what we do. This is a sacred responsibility of parents that cannot and should not be delegated to someone else, even the institutional church!

**APOSTOLATES IN THE CHURCH FOR FAITH FORMATION** In the Church, we have various apostolates and programs to partner with parents in faith formation. This never takes the place of the responsibility and role from the parents, but we partner to collectively share and witness to faith: we teach the truth of Jesus Christ and we form and shape our lives in accordance with the Gospel.

We currently have three different programs of religious education across our six parishes. St. John the Baptist in Petersburg partners with St. Michael's in Albion. St. Boniface in Elgin and St. Bonaventure in Raeville offer a Family Formation model for elementary and also Sunday Youth Group for Jr High/High School monthly on Sundays. St. Peter's in Ewing, St. Theresa's in Clearwater, and Rural St. John's share a Jr / Sr high school program and offer elementary formation at each of the communities with a grade school. We have two area Catholic grade schools at St. Boniface in Elgin and St. Michael in Albion. We have Pope John Central Catholic High School as an additional place to help educate and form disciples in the faith.

When I'm asked by parents about how to make sure that their children receive the gift of faith, I remind them that none of these programs or apostolates take the place of parents in faith formation. You cannot outsource the passing on of the gift of faith to someone else. Faith is passed on by living and sharing it.

#### **CELEBRATING AS A COMMUNITY**

One final note for this week. We are trying a policy for our parish communities. Each community can request one implemented change of Mass time per year within their "shift". We will be making a change of Mass times the weekend of Aug 31 – Sept 1 for St. John the Baptist in Petersburg's Parish Bazaar. [SBE-Sat 7PM / SBR-Sun 8AM / SJP-Sun 10AM] In October, we will change the mass schedule the weekend of the 27th and 28th to facilitate the Archbishop's visit and Confirmation.




