HOW IS IT THAT GOD SPEAKS TO US?

A very honest question asked on a recent Pope John Central Catholic class retreat was this “How do I know when God is speaking to me? What does his voice sound like?” This is at the heart of a lifelong relationship with God. God could have been a person who is distant, uncaring, and uninterested in our lives... but HE ISN'T! We have a God that created us, loves us, cares for us, speaks to us, and invites us to be his disciples with the whole of our lives.

I know that when I am trying to discern, figure out, or know God's will, I would really not mind a text message or some clearly written or illustrated instructions. In my experience, that's never happened. Although if I'm perfectly honest, I probably would not be great at following each step, in order, completely, and to the finish line.

God is not a Magic 8 ball, a genie in a bottle, or a puppet master pulling our strings. God chooses to accompany us and be with us in our lives and throughout our lives. He cares about what happens in our lives, but he does not control our lives. God doesn't care if we choose to wear the red shirt or the blue shirt (Although he seems to care that I wear a black shirt!). We make our own choices. We experience the effects of our own choices, and yet we encounter a God who can save and redeem us despite our choices. This means that there is a story of salvation for me and a story of salvation for you. The destination that we are searching for is heaven and eternal life together with God. Then the question arises “How do we get there?”

THE ONLY WAY TO HEAVEN IS JESUS

Getting into heaven is not something that we can do by wit, skill, or merit. We can't earn heaven. We have to receive it as the gift of God's love. We have to receive Jesus's saving work on the cross. We need the humility to accept a gift that we

couldn't earn. Our own pridefulness and stubbornness has to die so that we can accept the gift and live forever in heaven. Getting there, here and now, is an invitation to discipleship... to walking with and talking with Jesus.

WHAT IS A VOCATION? DO I HAVE ONE?

The word 'vocation' comes from the Latin word for a calling or an invitation. The Church Council Vatican II emphasized that each of us has a vocation, that there is *a universal call to holiness*, which means that everyone is invited and called to be a disciple of Jesus in being made ready for heaven... so by this understanding, each of us experiences a vocation and invitation from God.

THE CALL TO DISCIPLESHIP TAKES MANY FORMS

We also use the phrase “vocation” in a more specific way. There are different lifestyles within the church that are vocations. My vocation and Fr. Vogel's vocation is to serve, live, and love celibately as priests. Sr. Pat has taught math for many years at Pope John, but her vocation is to serve, live, and love celibately as a consecrated woman religious. Many in our communities are called to marry and form households. That calling is to serve, live, and love in a married way. Others live as witnesses in the single life, where there is a calling to serve, live, and love as well.

God calls us and invites us into vocations for the sake of our happiness and holiness. We're invited into the adventure of being a disciple. Jesus wants us to know his voice, hear his voice, and respond to his voice. Sometimes the first step in our lives is to consider the possibilities of vocations for me. When I started considering that God might be inviting me to be a priest, the possibility both excited and terrified me. There was a desire in my heart to explore this possibility, and I also feared how I might be changed by a vocation. Now I truly know that it is my vocation, and I couldn't imagine doing anything else. By embracing my vocation, it also deepens its rooting in my heart.

Next week, I'll speak a bit more about prayer and our relationship with God.

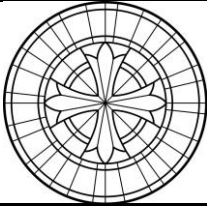
