PREACHING THE GOSPEL...AN INVITATION

Jesus started proclaiming the Good News with urgency in this week's Gospel. He says, "Repent, for the Kingdom of Heaven is at hand." In our English language, 'repent' is often associated with a sense of condemnation... It may not be hard to imagine someone wagging their finger at us and saying, "Repent, YOU SINNERS!" However, the word 'repent' in Greek can also mean "Consider this!" or "This might change your mind..."

Because the word 'gospel' means 'Good News', there's anticipation that you might want to hear what Jesus has to say. To accept the message of salvation, to accept that Jesus has suffered and died for my sins, to accept St. Paul's claim that I belong to Jesus Christ is the proclamation of an entire new way of life. We talk about a God who loves us... his love entirely changes us, if we let him.

TOO BUSY TO LISTEN

Our lives can be incredibly hectic. Everyone seems to be asking for a part of my time, every activity asks for a part of my time, my job asks for a part of my life, my family asks for time in my life, and we can find ourselves stretched to a breaking point. Even in retirement, people can have a full calendar. The Gospel isn't preached to people who have nothing to do. It isn't

waiting for everything in our lives and on our calendars to go away. The good news meets us in the middle of everything... and it invites us to consider a whole new way of life. The call to conversion and repentance is meant for both Christians and non-Christians. Life in Christ is an ordering, or even a reordering, of our lives.

CONSECRATION TO THE HOLY FAMILY

We continue to prepare for the consecration to the Holy Family on Feb 1-2. A consecration is asking for protection or patronage for this next year. **This is a consecration for everyone, whether married or single.** It is a consecration for each of us, our immediate and extended families, our communities of faith, and any special intentions or concerns that we bring forward as well. We are meant to bring our joys and hopes, our challenges and disappointments, and our fears and apprehensions. Naming what those things are, reflecting and thinking through them, and describing those realities helps us be aware of what we are dedicating and offering to the care of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph.
