### Selling Grain to Benefit Your Church:



Producers are reminded that the following needs to take place in order for you to legally remove the grain sale or livestock from your taxable income:

- 1) The commodity is delivered to facility.
  - 2) The donor signs a form (at the facility or from the parish office) that states the commodity now belongs to the charity.
  - 3) The facility mails the check/scale ticket to the charity.
- NOTE:** Donations of grain *in the charity's name* cannot be claimed as an itemized charitable contribution so therefore will be posted as such on your end of the year contribution statement from the parish. Questions: Contact Michele Reicks.



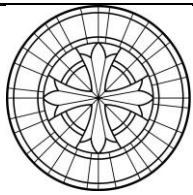

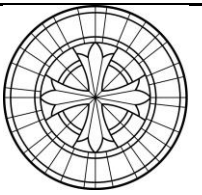
