Charitable Contributions Deduction Modifications

Taxpayers who do not otherwise elect to itemize deductions are allowed an above-the-line deduction in 2020 for up to \$300 for charitable contributions made in cash (not stock) to any qualifying Section 501(c)(3) public charity, excluding donor-advised funds. In addition, for individuals who itemize, the CARES Act temporarily increases limitations on deductions for charitable contributions made in 2020.

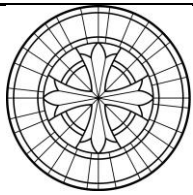

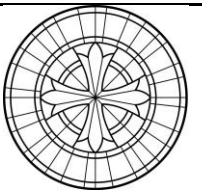
The Word Among Us Booklets for January/February 2021 will be in all churches starting December 31, for those who wish to take one.

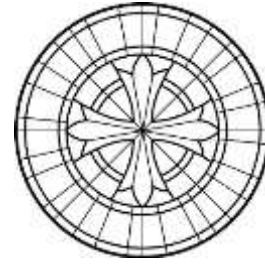
