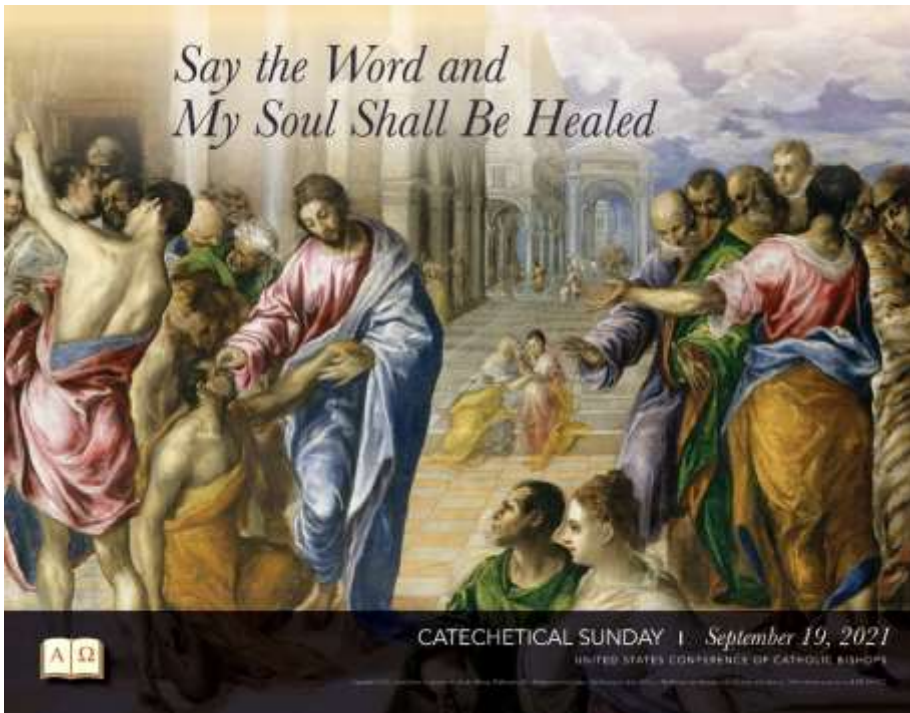
### The Man of the Shroud
