Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

June 26, 2022

In the Gospel this weekend Jesus invites us to "Follow me" (Luke 9:59). But some people come up with excuses to delay: "I need to bury my father first ... Let me go and say goodbye to my family." Jesus' reply may seem uncaring: "Let the dead bury their dead. ... No one who sets a hand to the plow and looks to what was left behind is fit for the kingdom of God." Jesus' words are meant to express that when God asks something of us, we ought to follow Jesus immediately, even if it means leaving behind something good, even if it means leaving one's family. When God calls us to a new way of serving him "Come, follow me," we should not cling to previous ways but embrace where he is sending us.

Fortunately, I have been given the gift of being able to say goodbye, this final weekend here with you. It has been a wonderful 6 years of being your priest. I have learned so much. The place of my first assignment as pastor, for St. Boniface and St. Bonaventure, will always hold a special place in my heart. I thank you so much for opening your parishes and your lives to me – for all the prayers and other gifts you have given me, for which I am so poor in always expressing my gratitude. "I give thanks to God always for all of you, remembering you in my prayers" (1 Thessalonians 1:2). In so far as I have been but a small instrument in helping you encounter Christ, I rejoice and thank God. For those moments I have come short – inadvertently or unknowingly caused harm – I ask your forgiveness.

It is the great privilege of the priest to be able to be a part of your lives, especially at so many important moments of your family. I have helped you "bury the dead" through over 80 funerals, but also worked with couples for 45 weddings, baptizing 9 of their children out of 96 baptisms. Comforting the sick through countless anointings, bringing the Father's mercy again and again through reconciliation, assisting in the preparation of those to receive the Holy Spirit in Confirmation, and being the conduit through which Christ has fed your souls with his daily bread, the Eucharist, in the Sacrifice of the Mass.

I feel blessed to have so many spiritual children, including your children that I have so much loved teaching in the school and in religious formation. It is difficult to leave. But just like Elisha in the first reading, just like the disciples in the gospel, the Lord has called me to leave this family of parishes, and go on to a new assignment. Since he has called, to them I must set my face. I rejoice knowing that the same Jesus Christ who was with you before I arrived will continue to be at the center of your lives after I go. As Elijah was followed by Elisha in role of prophet, I am happy that you will come to know Fr. Sund as another of your spiritual fathers after me. "I am confident of this, that the one who began a good work in you will continue to complete it until the day of Christ Jesus" (Philippians 1:6).

All the Christian faithful remain united to one another through the Mass and prayer; may we continue to lift each other up in our prayers. I depart with some words of the Father spoken through the prophet Isaiah, that you may never forget you are His beloved sons and daughters: "Thus says the LORD, who created you: Do not fear, for I have redeemed you; ... You are precious in my eyes and honored, and I love you, ... Fear not, for I am with you ... I have called you by name: you are mine" (Isaiah 43:1, 4a, 5a).
