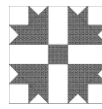
**Thank you to Louise Schindler who recently retired as our Sunday Youth Group coordinator, after 18 years!!**

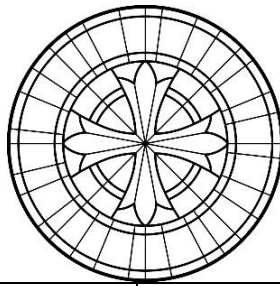

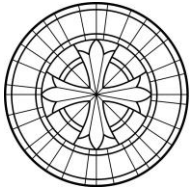

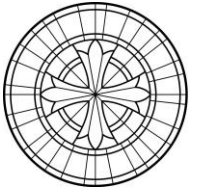
