


WALKING THROUGH THE MASS

Did You Know: The Mass is the "principle sacramental celebration of the Church". It's first celebration was in the upper room on Holy Thursday at the Last Supper. Each and every time the Mass is celebrated our participation in the death and glorious Resurrection of Christ is renewed. We are present at the very table of the Last Supper and are kneeling before the very altar of the cross at Calvary.

With this in mind, every single action and word of the Mass has a deep meaning. Over the history of the Church, the celebration of the Mass developed in such a way that our hearts and minds are able to be prepared to participate in the saving action of Christ. It is only through Christ's actions that we are saved, however, we must be open to his Spirit and our participation at Mass allows this to happen.

In the next several weeks, I hope to go over the parts of the Masses: different actions and prayers. I will sometimes explain the origin behind them. Other times, I will explain the spiritual or theological significance of each part. Today, we will briefly speak of the Entrance Procession.

The Entrance Procession is a spiritual symbol of our journey toward the heavenly Jerusalem. At Mass we take part in the heavenly liturgy. As the priest ascends the altar for the celebration of Mass, in a real way he enters into the eternal Mass that is taking part in the heavenly Jerusalem.


