

Fasting

- Those between the ages of 18 and 59 are to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.
- This consists of 1 full meal and 2 smaller meals during the day, without snacks.
- If one cannot for health reasons, they are exempt.



Abstinence from Meat

• Those **age 14 and older** are required to not eat meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all Fridays of Lent.
