What is more important - being rich in faith or rich in possessions? Society tells us that possessions are most important. God teaches a different lesson. When we are rich in faith, we keep God first and experience true joy and peace.

When we put possessions first, we soon realize we can never have enough, and happiness is fleeting.

When we put faith over possessions, we truly realize it is better to give than receive.



Happy Sunday!

We see the Lord's generosity since the Resurrection Day that we celebrate and worship God every Sunday is returned and given to us to be a day of rest. The Lord shows us that he wants us to be cared for. With the many changes that we are experiencing in our area, I'm hoping that a bulletin column will help increase both communication and understanding. Reality is a complex thing. Some of the topics may interest you and some may not. Some writings may be more spiritual in nature, and some may be more pragmatic and practical. Today's topic is property insurance. The Archdiocese made some significant changes to the insurance program this year.

Each church and school campus in the Archdiocese of Omaha is covered by an umbrella policy for the entire Archdiocese negotiated by the Chancery office with Catholic Mutual Group. Catholic Mutual is a nonprofit insurance group that the Archdiocese of Omaha helped found in 1889, and it continues to serve only Church-owned institutions in the United States and Canada. The goal of this umbrella policy is to have good insurance coverage and affordable premiums.

The insurance market keeps changing, and property insurance keeps getting more expensive. You may have noticed that insurance rates for farms, buildings, and property have all gone up. Weather events like hail, derecho straight winds, tornadoes, and hurricanes have caused losses that require premiums to go up. For the 2023-2024 year, the insurance premiums went up 34%. In order to prevent another huge increase in premiums, the Archdiocese made modifications to the insurance policy. Even with these changes, our premiums for the 2024-2025 year will still rise 14% over last year.

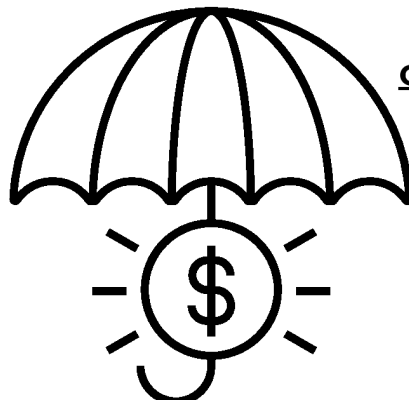
- The parish maintenance deductible for property claims has been raised from \$2,500 to \$10,000.
- A roof depreciation schedule was added to adjust claims payment
 - 0-10 years old is Replacement Cost Value (if applicable)
 - 11-20 years old is Actual Cash Value based on 25% depreciation
 - Over 20 years old is Actual Cash Value based on 50% depreciation
 - Superficial or cosmetic damage will also not be paid as a claim.

Several of our church campuses experienced complete roof replacement in the past few years as a result of hail damage while only having to pay the \$2,500 deductible. These current changes in policy would have made those replacement costs significantly higher at the time. It would have been a bigger stressor on a church's cash flow and cash reserves.

This change is going to require us to consider how we plan for maintenance expenses in the future. This expense is a prerequisite for our church family to worship and do ministry. Because of how significant this expense is, we have a special envelope/collection to directly offset this expense. If your packet does not have a specially marked envelope, please consider contributing with an envelope marked insurance.

Missionary Priest Fr. Richard Mais to visit September 14-15 & 21-22



Objective of Financial Mission Appeal for The Diocese of Eldoret – Kenya – 2024

The Diocese of Eldoret extends to the region called Kerio valley in the Great Rift valley of Kenya. The poverty level in this dry area is so high. Our request of financial appeal is meant to build some classrooms and provide piped clean water and bathrooms for our primary school in this region of the Diocese. The Diocese of Eldoret has been serving poor people in the Kerio valley of Kenya irrespective of their faith religion since in 1960s. There is a big gap in the area of basic education especially for poor children. We began the efforts of establishing a primary school focusing on quality education for the poor children. Currently, we only have two Catholic primary schools in an area that has 3 wide parishes with 21 Mission churches. The public schools in this region are overcrowded and with gender and special disparities. Many girls are left out or have higher chances of dropping out of schools than boys due to parents using them to do more chores at home. Our schools will treat all children equally and promote a good school retention of the girl child. We aim to have at least 10% of children with disabilities coming from all over the region. We hope to combat the social exclusion of the poorest with social scholarships.

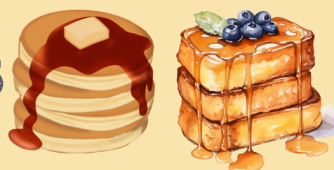
