





Campaign for the Mary's Garden

NCCW in 1998 established a campaign to create Mary's Garden on the property of the Shrine of the Immaculate Conception in Washington, DC. This campaign made it possible for a beautiful statue of Mary to be erected in a space where there would be a living garden with a water fountain where visitors to the shrine could pause, rest, reflect and pray during their visit. Over the last 25 years, hundreds of thousands of visitors and pilgrims have benefited from this holy space at the shrine.

In May of this year, NCCW received a call letting us know that the statue and garden had been vandalized. After reviewing the statue, the insurance company determined that the statue needed to be replaced, not repaired. Not only did the statue get damaged but so did the garden. We are grateful that the statue will be replaced through insurance. However, the garden, fountain and stone pavement are not covered.

The Executive Committee has agreed to reach out to our membership and friends of NCCW to raise funds to complete the repairs needed for Mary's Garden. This Campaign of Mary's Garden will help to continue to be a source of prayer and solitude for the hundreds of thousands of visitors and pilgrims who enjoy this garden.

As we celebrate the 25th Anniversary of Mary's Garden, we invite you to consider giving a donation to assist with the rebuilding of this significant NCCW project. Many of us have enjoyed the presence of the garden during visits to the shrine while attending the Board of Directors meetings, during the March for Life and many other opportunities we have had to visit the shrine.

After the 2024 convention is completed, the campaign will begin on September 8, 2024 (the Birth of Mary) and will conclude on May 31st (Feast of the Visitation). During this time, you will be able to send in your donation, call in your donation or make a donation through the NCCW website. We need to raise \$80,000.00 to continue to support this significant NCCW project that has been with us for 25 years.

Once the renovation has been complete in late spring, we will have a rededication of Mary's Garden at the Shrine of the Immaculate Conception in Washington, DC.

As the current NCCW President, I ask that you share this news with family, friends, spiritual advisors, parishioners and co-workers. May Our Lady of Good Counsel watch over this campaign and inspire those who hear about it to support this important project.

The Omaha Archdiocesan Council of Catholic Women

OACCW College Scholarship

The Omaha Archdiocesan Council of Catholic Women (OACCW) will offer an annual scholarship to a female high school senior in the Archdiocese of Omaha in the amount of \$750.00. This scholarship serves to enlighten, inform, and inspire young Catholic women regarding the OACCW as the major organization of Catholic Women in the Omaha Archdiocese. The scholarship will be awarded to a deserving high school senior woman who resides in or is affiliated with a parish within the Archdiocese of Omaha.

1. To apply for this scholarship, the high school senior needs to be a Catholic female. She must submit the completed application form, with transcripts attached, and a priest, school/parish staff, or faculty evaluation. The essay that accompanies the application is essential, and will be used as a primary source for consideration of the scholarship award. All documentation should be submitted to her Deanery Council of Catholic Women President or scholarship chairperson, and be postmarked or received by January 15. Late applications will not be considered. The name and address of the Deanery President or Chairperson may be obtained through her school Counselor.

In the event that there is not an active deanery for her parish, or her deanery does not offer a deanery scholarship, she will send her application to the Scholarship Chairperson of the Omaha Archdiocese, Kim Estes, 87671 467th Ave Stuart, NE 68780. This will insure she will be considered as an applicant in the archdiocesan contest.

- 2. The local Deanery Council of Catholic Women (DCCW) will select from these applications, one that they think has met the qualifications of this scholarship, and an alternate winner. The winner at this level in the local CCW Deanery will receive a scholarship in an amount determined by the local Deanery. The Deanery CCW will then forward the worthy application to the OACCW by February 15.
- The OACCW will select one recipient and an alternate by March 15.
- 4. The OACCW recipient will be notified and awarded a scholarship certificate presented to her personally by the OACCW President at a Mass in her home parish in April or May, if possible.
- 5. A check for \$750.00 will be given to the recipient upon proof of her college enrollment.
- 6. The OACCW President or Chairperson of the Scholarship Committee will send a letter of thanks to the finalists for applying. Information about OACCW may be included.
